Community Health Literacy Program Starts Strong

SBPHC's Community Health Literacy (CHL) program has started on a very strong note. In its first month, our seven community partners have harnessed the training they received to connect with more than 800 community members about seeking and using health insurance.

Our CHL program community partners are: ArchCare, Bronx Community Health Network, Health People, The Bronx Health Link, BronxWorks, Mary Mitchell Family & Youth Center, and Regional Aid for Interim Needs (R.A.I.N). BPHC issued an RFP for this project in Summer 2016.

Using a curriculum developed by NYC Human Resources Administration's Office of Health Insurance Access, the organizations employ their resources and community partnerships to implement outreach strategies that meet people where they live and work.

In one month, they have reached people through more than 40 education sessions as well as open houses and street outreach. Going forward, partners will also be working with Health Homes.

As the CHL program continues this year, it will also begin to focus on helping people navigate the health system through a curriculum developed by Memorial Sloan Kettering Immigrant Health and Cancer Disparities Service.
