Diabetes Self-Management Program Seeking Host Sites

It works. That's what Loretta Fleming, featured right, says about the Diabetes Self-Management Program (DSMP), a free workshop that teaches adults with Type 2 Diabetes how to better understand and manage their disease.

Health People and BPHC have partnered to bring this powerful workshop to a range of organizations including clinics, hospitals, churches, and community groups, enabling their patients and participants to gain control over their diabetes.

Like Loretta, participants regularly report improved A1C levels, weight loss, better eating habits and more energy. DSMP is an evidenced-based program led by "Peer Leaders," people who also live with Type 2 Diabetes and have been trained and certified to be DSMP instructors.


"The program has changed lives and we can reach even more people if we expand our locations," says Chris Norwood, Executive Director, Health People, which recruits and trains DSMP Peer Leaders.

Classes are two-and-a-half hours and take place once a week for seven weeks. Classroom space should be able to accommodate 18 people seated at tables.
