Innovation Fund Conference Call January 8, 2018 Q&A

1. Who do you identify as your care management organizations in the BPHC PPS?

- ✓ *We have three Health Homes in our PPS: (1) Bronx Accountable Health Care Network (BAHN), (2) Coordinated Behavioral Care (CBC) and (3) Community Care Management Partners (CCMP).*
- ✓ *BPHC can send out a list of all the care management agencies (CMA) associated with the Health Homes upon request.*
- ✓ *For questions regarding any particular CMA(s), we recommend that you contact the Health Homes directly.*

2. How many partners in BPHC's PPS specifically work with the justice-involved/re-entry populations?

- ✓ *We have a few with such specific population focus, but we do not have a separate "category" of partners working for this population.*

3. Who do you consider your client list for the Innovation Fund?

- ✓ *The population of focus will be Medicaid-enrolled or eligible clients from the Bronx. We currently cannot identify DSRIP attributed clients (e.g., names, addresses etc.) for you to target specifically. We do expect organizations to have a greater understanding of the population they serve including the rough size and the conditions their population faces.*

4. Can you please clarify what can be included under administrative costs?

- ✓ *BPHC will not fund indirect or overhead costs for the purposes of the Innovation Fund. Requests for overhead costs (i.e., rent, utilities, etc.) must be justified in the narrative as specifically needed and incurring due to the pilot work. For example, if your pilot program requires a hotline or equipment for communications, BPHC will review for consideration.*
- ✓ *Administrative costs that are managed by staff should be included as line items as FTE.*
- ✓ *The nature of the Innovation Fund is to test pilots. BPHC would like to see innovative ideas for addressing challenging populations and their needs.*

5. How should Innovation Fund proposals be submitted?

- ✓ *Please review previous e-mail blasts which include hyperlinks and instructions for submission. All proposal materials should be submitted through Form Assembly.*

6. Can you please clarify what the follow-up care is like for children prescribed ADHD medication during the initiation phase?

- ✓ *That metric is part of the Community Behavioral Health Initiative (CBHI), which is a separate BPHC initiative and NOT part of the Innovation Fund.*

7. Will previous proposals that do not target the identified population of interest be considered for this round?

- ✓ *We would encourage you to refine the proposal to target the specified population for this round that includes the behavioral health, justice-involved and medically homeless populations. (Please note that this is for a few proposals specifically designated and notified by the CSO as “modify and re-submit” – the rest of the proposals from the last round should have been consulted with the CSO to ascertain if it is deemed proficient to modify and re-submit.)*
