BPHC Members Receive \$6.6 Million in Pay for Performance Distributions

BPHC organizations eligible for participation in Pay for Performance (P4P) measures were awarded \$6.6 million in distributions. In total, 150 organizations received performance-based award distributions for DSRIP Measurement Year 2 (MY2) - the time period of July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.

P4P amounts were based on organizations' impact on HEDIS measures and their level of participation in our PPS. Organizations can use their P4P awards at their own discretion (see story below on how one community center used their award).
