Social Determinants of Health and the Law

Description

Many of the social and environmental conditions affecting our community members' health can be addressed through legal solutions.

This one-day course, developed by LegalHealth and BPHC, helps patient advocates understand and recognize when their patients or clients may need legal assistance or intervention to address issues like housing, immigration or domestic violence.

Participants will learn to recognize when a legal referral may be helpful and will be provided with a comprehensive Legal Referral Resource list for Bronx patients.
