BPHC Webinar: Non-Emergency Medical Transportation for Medicaid Recipients

Transportation is a covered benefit that enables Medicaid recipients to go to critical medical visits, including primary and behavioral healthcare, dialysis, and pre-natal care.

In New York City, the state Department of Health has contracted with MAS (Medical Answering Services) to authorize non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) via taxi and livery services, ambulette, non-emergency ambulance, and more.

Join us for a webinar that covers how the state's NEMT system works, including the range of services it offers, eligibility, and how BPHC can assist in your efforts to pilot NEMT for your patients and clients.

NYS DOH Health Launches VBP University Sophomore Year

The Department of Health (DOH) has launched its Value Based Payment University (VBP-U), Sophomore Year.

VBP-U is an online, educational resource created to raise awareness and understanding in the move to VBP.

Building off last year's VBP-U success, VBP-U: Sophomore Year provides a deeper dive into VBP fundamentals. The Semester 1 curriculum includes information on the Medicare Access & Children's Health Insurance Reauthorization Act (MACRA), guidance documents for Chief Medical Officers, and guidance documents for addressing social determinants of health through VBP.

The tentative schedule for the rollout of VBP-U is:

Semester 1 – July 2018

Semester 2 – August 2018

Semester 3 – September 2018

Semester 4 – September 2018 (VBP Bootcamp)

Semesters 1-3 will conclude with a quiz on the topics covered. Those who pass with a grade of 80% or higher will receive a certificate of completion by the DOH.
