- Have all CRPA certification and exam fees covered by the program
- Earn nine credits towards a Public Health Administration Associate Degree at Bronx Community College
- Receive connections to employment opportunities!

#### PARTICIPANTS MUST:

- have an annual income under \$30k
- have a High School Diploma / TASC
- be at least 18 years of age
- be eligible to work in the U.S.
- have the passion and desire to guide and serve those in recovery
